Many will come from east and west, and from north and south; and sit at table in the Kingdom of God.

At Emmaus, when our risen Lord was at table with those who had walked with him, he took the bread and blessed and broke it, and gave it to them.

Then their eyes were opened and they recognised him. In the same way now he invites all who choose to trust him to share in the broken bread.

So Come to this table, you who have much faith and you who would like to have more;

Come to this table, you who have been to here often and you who have not been for a long time;

Come to this table, you who have tried to follow Jesus and you who have failed.

Come, it is Christ who invites us to meet him here.

What we do here, we do in imitation of what Christ first did.

On the night on which he was betrayed; and as they were sitting at a meal, Jesus took a piece of bread and broke it. He gave it to the disciples saying, "This is my body broken for you. do this in remembrance of me."

Later, after they had eaten,

he took a cup of wine and he said,
"This cup is the new relationship with God
made possible because of my death.
Drink this all of you, and remember me."

So now we do as Jesus did.
